Portfolios:

- Applicants must be a resident of Coles County
- Applicants must be entering the 9th grade in the fall, be a high school student, or have recently graduated from high school. (the semester before Art School)
- Applicants must submit samples of art work done with in the last twelve months in a simple cardboard portfolio which is easy to open and sturdy enough to withstand normal wear and tear. The portfolio and its contents may not exceed 24" x 36". If larger 2-D and 3-D art works are to be included, a photograph may be substituted. Do not send actual three-dimensional or oversized work. Two-Dimensional art works should be matted and slip-sheeted to protect the images.
- No more than 10 examples may be submitted and the art work should be selected to give the judge a true assessment of the applicant's art ability and potential. Questions concerning applications should be directed to Natalie Boyer, Director-Visual Arts, Coles County Arts Council at 348-5930.
- All portfolios, art work, slides, or photographs must have the applicant's name clearly visible on either the front or back of each of them. Incomplete application forms or portfolios will not be considered.
